## ORDER OF POSTPONEMENT OF MAY 2, 2020 TRUSTEE ELECTION

As a result of the Proclamation by Governor Greg Abbott authorizing the postponement of the May 2, 2020 election until November 3, 2020, the Board of Trustees of Ennis ISD finds, and pursuant to the State of Texas Election Advisory No. 2020-12:

That the Board so chooses to exercise this authority granted by the Governor's proclamation;

That the election called for May 2, 2020, for the purpose of electing two (2) School Board Trustees is postponed and will take place on November 3, 2020;

That the current candidate filings that were timely filed for the May 2, 2020 election will remain valid for the November 3, 2020 election date; the filing period will not be re-opened for the November election date;

That ABBMs (Applications for Ballot by Mail) received for voters that are voting by mail due to being over the age of 65 or due to disability will still be valid for the postponed election;

That ABBMs for voters who submitted ABBMs based on expected absence from the County will not be valid for the postponed election;

That the major relevant dates for the November election are:

- Voter registration deadline is October 5, 2020
- The deadline to submit an ABBM is October 23, 2020
- The dates for early voting will be October 19 through October 30, 2020;

That the Ennis ISD Board of Trustees will take action no later than August 17, 2020 to make any necessary revisions to the original Order of Election.
